A 5-10-10 slow-release fertilizer can be applied late spring and mid-summer but not after August 15th Most hydrangea do well in a slightly acidic soil It is this lower pH in the 40 to 50 range that makes aluminum ions in the soil available to *Hydrangea macrophylla* and gives them blue blossoms In order to have pink blossoms the soil pH must

Blue or Pink Blossoms Big leaf hydrangeas have the ability to change flower color based on the pH of the soil Other than Blushing Bride, which is a white hydrangea, soil with a pH below 60 (acidic soil) will produce blue hydrangea blooms and a pH above 60 will produce pink hydrangea blooms In the spring, do not remove the mulch too fast

A Quick Guide to Pruning Hydrangeas Types of hydrangeas Bigleaf hydrangea, H macrophylla This is the most commonly grown hydrangea in Maryland It has attractive, lustrous leaves and large blue, pink, red, or purple flowers These hydrangeas include two forms: the mophead and the lacecap types Both are pruned the same way
