Drama for Learning and Creativity (D4LC)

D4LC involves training and supporting primary and secondary teachers (whether drama experienced or not) to become better at working alongside Drama in schools develops this The teachers may also elect to attend 26 hours of drama training sessions and can attend teacher drama network sessions
